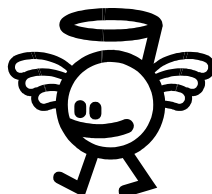

Epiphany

The word “Epiphany” means to make manifest.

The feast of the three kings is called by this name because this is when Jesus was made manifest, or know, to the Gentiles, to the whole non-Jewish world of which we are all a part. It is celebrated on the Sunday after New Year’s Day.

This day is often called little Christmas, and in many European cultures, it is the traditional day for gift-giving.

Another tradition associated with the Epiphany is the blessing of the home and the marking of the door with 20 + C+B+M+08. The number represent the year, the letter, the names of the three wise men, Caspar, Balthasar, and Melchior
