**The Freedom of Choice Act**

The **Catholic Bishops** of the United States **opposed** the Freedom of Choice Act (**FOCA**). If this legislation were to pass three decades of Pro Life policies, at both the national and state level would be overturned. The FOCA would legislate a fundamental right to abortion, even Partial Birth Abortion. It would also strip parents of their right to be involved in their minor daughter's abortion decision.
