An old Italian custom worthy reviving is to present your palm branch to someone you have offended as a sign of reconciliation.

The Chrism Mass

Holy Week begins with a diocesan-wide celebration called the Chrism Mass, in which all the priests gather with their bishop to renew their dedication to priestly service. The Oil of the Sick and the Oil of the Catechumens are blessed, while the Sacred Chrism used during baptism, confirmation and ordination is consecrated by the bishop. The bishop distributes the oils to the pastors and pastoral coordinators for their parishes.

Holy Week Services

These beautiful services are not too long for families. What is wonderful is that these liturgies are so different from the Sunday liturgy: foot washing, a procession with the Blessed Sacrament, veneration of the Cross, the lighting of the Easter fire and the blessing of the new Easter Candle. “*The Lord has an ocean to give. Don’t come with teaspoons.*” Sri Bhaganwan. Come, be filled with the Lord on the holiest week of the year.
