Didache, 50-100 A.D. Jewish Christian Liturgical text. Here is part of what it says:

" At the Eucharist, offer the eucharistic prayer in this way. Begin with the chalice: 'We give thanks to you, our Father, for the holy wine of your servant David which you have made known to us through your servant Jesus. Glory be to you, world without end.'

Then over the broken bread: ' We give you thanks to you, our Father, for the life and knowledge you have made known to us through your servant Jesus. Glory be to you, world without end.'

As this broken bread once dispersed over the hills, was brought together and became one loaf, so may your Church be brought together from the ends of the earth into your kingdom."
