Monday evening, January 18 to recognize the gift of our clergy with a dinner of appreciation. Eight priests and two deacons were present; sixteen priests serve the people of God in the Valley in a variety of ministries. The priests serving the three parishes and mission in the Valley represents over 600 years of dedication. There are two diocesan priests and thirteen order priests living in the valley, from four different orders: the Congregation of the Sacred Hearts of Jesus and Mary, the Congregation of Franciscan Friars of the Immaculate Virgin, the Congregation of the Holy Spirit and the Missionaries of the Sacred Heart. These men live simple lives of prayer. Their congregations have a global ministry serving in parishes, schools and the missions around the world.
