### Juvenile Justice Week of Faith: Feb. 15 - 21, 2010

During this month of February, the Diocesan Office of Restorative Justice would like to draw attention to the plight of children who have been victims of violent crime, as well as incarcerated children. In California, there were 232,849 juvenile arrests in 2006. That is the equivalent of more than 600 juvenile arrests each day. In 2005, 3,006 children and teenagers in the United States died of firearm injuries. Please join us in praying for these youth and all those affected by juvenile crime.

There is much more that can be done about this including supporting local programs that offer character-building opportunities to young people and divert their energy to positive activities; becoming better informed about the juvenile justice system and advocating for legislation that restores and heals all involved; and supporting programs that reach out to victims and family members of the incarcerated. Monday evening, January 18 to recognize the gift of our clergy with a dinner of appreciation. Eight priests and two deacons were present; sixteen priests serve the people of God in the Valley in a variety of ministries. The priests serving the three parishes and mission in the Valley represents over 600 years of dedication. There are two diocesan priests and thirteen order priests living in the valley, from four different orders: the Congregation of the Sacred Hearts of Jesus and Mary, the Congregation of Franciscan Friars of the Immaculate Virgin, the Congregation of the Holy Spirit and the Missionaries of the Sacred Heart. These men live simple lives of prayer. Their congregations have a global ministry serving in parishes, schools and the missions around the world.

**Health Ministry**

A recent letter to our parish from Bishop Barnes encouraged Catholic Churches in the Diocese to consider starting a Health Ministry or volunteer for existing Health Ministry Programs in their Parishes. Holy Spirit started our Health ministry in 1998!
