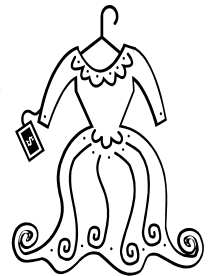

What is Eucharistic Adoration?

Is the act of worshiping God as He is present in the consecrated Eucharist. Spending time before the Blessed Sacrament, in prayer and devotion, is exactly the same as spending time before the living God.



Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament

The devotion begins with exposition of the Blessed Sacrament. The purpose of adoration is to highlight the presence of Our Lord in the Eucharist. Adoration ceremonies traditionally include Scripture readings, hymns, prayers, and time for silent adoration.

Mass, Exposition, Forty Hours Devotion, Perpetual Adoration, Benediction, Procession.
